2nd Annual Pevely-Herculaneum Christmas Parade to be held on Thursday, December 1

The second annual Pevely-Herculaneum Christmas Parade will be held on Thursday, December 1, beginning at 7:00 p.m. The theme for this year's parade is "The Songs of Christmas". The parade will begin at the Pevely Elementary School on Main Street and travel through Pevely on Main Street and Old State Road to Lions Drive. After turning onto Lions Drive and then onto Commercial Boulevard, the parade will enter Herculaneum on North Joachim Avenue. The parade will travel south on Joachim Avenue past the Herculaneum school campus and end at the Herculaneum City Park.

CITY OF HERCULANEUM RECYCLING PROGRAM



The City of Herculaneum and our household waste service provider, Republic/CWI of Missouri, want to join with our residents to maintain a clean environment and do our part to recycle as much household waste as possible. **THERE IS NO ADDITIONAL FEE FOR RECYCLING IN HERCULANEUM!!**

Currently, the **voluntary** recycling program includes the following acceptable items: 1) tin/steel food and beverage containers 2) aluminum food and beverage containers 3) plastic items - #1, #2, #3, #4, #5 & #7 4) cardboard items (corrugated boxes, shoe boxes, etc.) 5) papers including magazines, newspapers, office papers and mail. Newspapers should be removed from the plastic wrappers. **Glass items & #6 Styrofoam containers are not accepted!**

ALL RECYCLABLES CAN BE PLACED IN THE SAME RECYCLE TOTE EACH WEEK. RECYCLABLE ITEMS DO NOT NEED TO BE SEPARATED!

Items not to be placed in the recycle totes include: animals, batteries, concrete, hazardous waste, motor oil, paint, phone books, plastic shopping bags, Styrofoam, garbage and yard waste.

Items should be placed in the recycle containers and set curbside by 6:00 a.m. on Monday morning.

Households wanting to recycle household wastes will be provided with recycle totes with lids. The trash hauling company is in the process of replacing all recycle totes with new BLUE color covered totes. Residents can obtain the new covered totes by calling Herculaneum City Hall. The uncovered recycle bins will be replaced at that time.

HERCULANEUM TREE BOARD TO SPONSOR TREE PRUNING SEMINAR

The Herculaneum Tree Board will sponsor a tree pruning training seminar on Saturday, December 10, 2011, at the Herculaneum fire station, 151 Riverview Plaza Drive, beginning at 10:00 a.m. The seminar will be presented by arborist Phil Berwick of Living Tree Care, Inc. and will include information on correct pruning techniques. INFORMATION FOR YARD WASTE COLLECTION DURING WINTER MONTHS

During the winter months (November through April) yard waste will be picked up **ONLY** on the third Wednesday of each month. All yard waste **must be placed in brown paper yard waste bags**. Limbs will be collected, if bundled together, and are no longer than four (4) feet in length. Yard waste must be placed curbside before 6:00 a.m. on collection day. Twice a month collection of yard waste will resume in May 2012 and continue through October 2012. For more information, please call City Hall at 636 475-4447.

TUESDAY BULK ITEM COLLECTION

Bulk items are collected on Tuesday of each week on an "ON CALL" basis. Please contact City Hall before the close of business (4:30 p.m.) on Monday before the Tuesday collection. Items that will not be collected include: tires, vehicle parts, motors, motor oil, broken glass or paint cans. **APPLIANCES:** Appliance collection requires a \$10.00 sticker purchased at City Hall. Any appliance containing Freon must have a certified sticker stating that all Freon and gases have been professionally removed. All items should be placed curbside before 6:00 a.m. on collection day. **Filing Period for April 3, 2012 Municipal Election
begins on Tuesday, December 13**

On Tuesday, April 3, 2011, voters will elect three aldermen (one in Ward I, one in Ward II and one in Ward III) and the Municipal Judge.

Candidates for all four positions can file at Herculaneum City Hall beginning at 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, December 13, 2011. The deadline for filing for office is Tuesday, January 17, 2012 at 5:00 p.m.

Candidates must be 21 years of age, a registered voter, a resident of Herculaneum for at least one year prior to the election, not be in arrears of any city taxes or utilities and show proof of payment for 2011 personal and real estate taxes.

The municipal election will be held at the Herculaneum Fire Department, 151 Riverview Plaza Drive (next to the Herculaneum Buchheit store).

**Major Improvements Made to the Governor
Daniel Dunklin Burial Site in Herculaneum**

Situated on a high bluff overlooking the Mississippi River is the burial site of Daniel Dunklin, the fifth Governor of Missouri. The burial site includes the graves of the former governor, his wife, son, daughter, grandson and great-grandson.

Since late summer, the burial site has been undergoing major improvements to the parking area, access trail and area around the gravesite. Additionally, the view of the Mississippi River from the burial site has been greatly enhanced. The improvements have been under the direction of the Missouri Department of Natural Resources.

The Daniel Dunklin Burial Site, the smallest Missouri state park, is located at the end of Dunklin Drive in Herculaneum.
