## 17th ANNUAL ARBOR DAY CELEBRATION - FRIDAY, APRIL 28

The City of Herculaneum and Herculaneum Today & Tomorrow (HT&T) will host the 16th Annual Arbor Day Celebration on Friday, April 28. The celebration will be held at the Herculaneum City Park beginning at 10:00 am.

The celebration will include the presentation of the 2022 Tree City USA Award from the Arbor Day Foundation. The City of Herculaneum will be receiving this designation for the sixteenth year.

The celebration will also include an Arbor Day proclamation and the announcement of the 5th grade Arbor Day Poster Contest winners. Students from the Herculaneum High School band and vocal music programs will participate in the event with various musical selections. Other high school students will participate through Arbor Day poems and readings. The ceremony will also include a tree planting.
